Welcome game: group puzzle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Let's work together to match up these puzzle pieces 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Simple jig saw or similar puzzle
Attention grabber: traffic lights / stop and go signs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When you are driving in the car with mum and dad what do the traffic lights mean? <red = stop; green = go> They are rules for driving so that everyone is safe. What would happen if cars didn't stop when the light turned red? Traffic lights are road rules to keep everyone happy and safe on the road, God gave Moses some rules for the people to keep them happy and safe... 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Picture of traffic lights
Story and question time: Moses with tablets of stone <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using pictures tell the story of God giving the people rules to keep them happy and safe What sort of rules would keep the people happy and safe? <do not tell lies, do not steal, do not kill people, love God, be obedient to your parents> Moses went up onto Mt Sinai for 40 days and was given the tablets of stone by God 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pictures
Craft activity: collage picture of Moses with tablets of stone <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Give everyone a picture of Moses holding the tablets of stone Decorate the picture and stick it into Sunday School books <cotton wool for Moses' beard and hair; coloured crepe paper for clothes; pre cut tablet of stone shapes from textured cardboard> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pre print pictures Cotton wool Coloured crepe paper Pre cut tablet shapes
Craft activity: Traffic lights <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Give everyone a strip of black paper or cardboard (A4 cut in half lengthways) Give everyone three coloured circles, talk about the colours and the sequence. Glue together traffic lights 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Black paper / cardboard Circles of red, yellow and green paper Glue
Listening skills activity: Stop and Go <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Listening very carefully to the instructions ... Everyone jump < STOP / GO> Everyone wiggle < STOP / GO> Everyone put your hands in the air < STOP / GO> Everyone stamp your feet < STOP / GO> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stop sign Go sign
Song time: 10 commandments (Tune: "My bonnie lies over the ocean") Our God gave to Moses commandments, ten rules they received to obey. Our God gave to Moses to commandments. Ten rules we should know them today."	
Craft activity: Numbers one to ten <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How many fingers do you have? How many toes do you have? God gave Moses ten commandments Glue the numbers one to ten into the book, stick in ten spot stickers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Numbers 1 – 10 Sticker spots
Memory verse: Jesus said "Love each other." John 15:17 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have a new memory verse. Jesus said "Love each other" ... can you think of some ways that we can show we love each other? <helping, kind words, not fighting, etc.> Practice saying it and give everyone a sticker for trying 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Memory verse sheets Stickers
