

Activity	Materials
<p>Warm up / welcome game: Listening game</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give everyone a musical instrument • Listening carefully for instructions ... stop, go, loud, slow, quietly like a mouse, loudly like an elephant, etc. 	Musical instruments
<p>Attention grabber: A hat for a king</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is a king in our story today. He was a good king ... let me see if I can find the right hat for a king to wear. <try several before you put on the crown> 	Variety of hats and a crown
<p>Story and question time: Hezekiah talks to God</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hezekiah was a good King. He listened to God's word and cleaned out the temple so that the people could worship God. • When Hezekiah was old, he got sick. He was so sick he was going to die. • Hezekiah was very sad and he prayed to God to help him. • God said Hezekiah would live for 15 more years. <count together to 15> 	Use a shoe box as the temple (glue a picture of the temple to the front), fill it with pieces of paper and the children can help clean the temple out.
<p>Craft time: Listening to God</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hezekiah was a good king who listened to God, what do you use for listening? Is it your nose, your eyes, your elbows? • Colour and cut out the ears • Tape to the arms of toy glasses or to a cardboard headband 	Ear templates Headband of cardboard Or Toy glasses
<p>Music time: You can tell the Lord that you love Him</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Let's sing this song about loving God. (optional streamers or shakers) 	"You can tell the Lord that you love him" (Colin Buchanan: Follow the Saviour, Track 9) CD and CDplayer required.
<p>Craft time: Crowns</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is a big job being king you have a lot of people to look after, a lot of decisions to make • Let's make some crowns so you can pretend to be King Hezekiah. • Give everyone a cardboard crown template to decorate. • Tape to fit. 	Precut crown templates Coloured paper, pens or stickers to decorate
<p>Memory verse: I always pray with joy. Philippians 1:4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who do we talk to when we pray? • Why does praying make us feel happy? • This is our memory verse. I am going to say it a few times, can you say it too? • Give everyone a sticker for trying. 	memory verse sheets stickers
