LESSON 22

THE KIND MAN

Luke 10:25-37

Jesus told a story about a man who went on a journey. On the way he was attacked by robbers, who hurt him, took everything he had, and left him badly injured by the roadside.

A man came along the road, and walked straight past. Another man came along. He looked at the sick man, but kept on going without helping him.

A third man came along, who was a Samaritan. He bandaged the poor man's sores and wounds, put him on his donkey and took him to an inn. He paid the innkeeper to care for him until he was well again.

Jesus told this story to teach us to care for one another, to be helpful and kind.

ACTIVITY

Cut up a bandaid and cover the man's wounds. Paste sand along the roadway. Use sandpaper for the hills. Paint or colour the picture.

FURTHER SUGGESTIONS

Discuss how we can help someone in trouble.

Act out the story.

Use a sandtray to illustrate the story with rocks for the hills, and peg, pipe cleaner or playdough people.

Make a donkey out of cardboard. Add wool for the mane and tail. Cut out and paste the sick man on its back. Draw windows and a door on a large shoebox to make an inn.
